Soft Washing

- **How It Works:** Soft washing uses low-pressure water combined with eco-friendly cleaning solutions to gently clean surfaces and kill organic growth like algae, mold, and mildew.
- Best For: More delicate surfaces such as:
 - Roof shingles
 - Vinyl or wood siding
 - Fences and decks
- Benefits:
 - o Safe for fragile surfaces
 - o Cleans and sanitizes by killing growth at its root
 - o Longer-lasting results compared to pressure washing alone
- **Considerations:** Soft washing is not for removing heavy dirt or oil stains on concrete—it's designed for organic buildup and surface protection.
